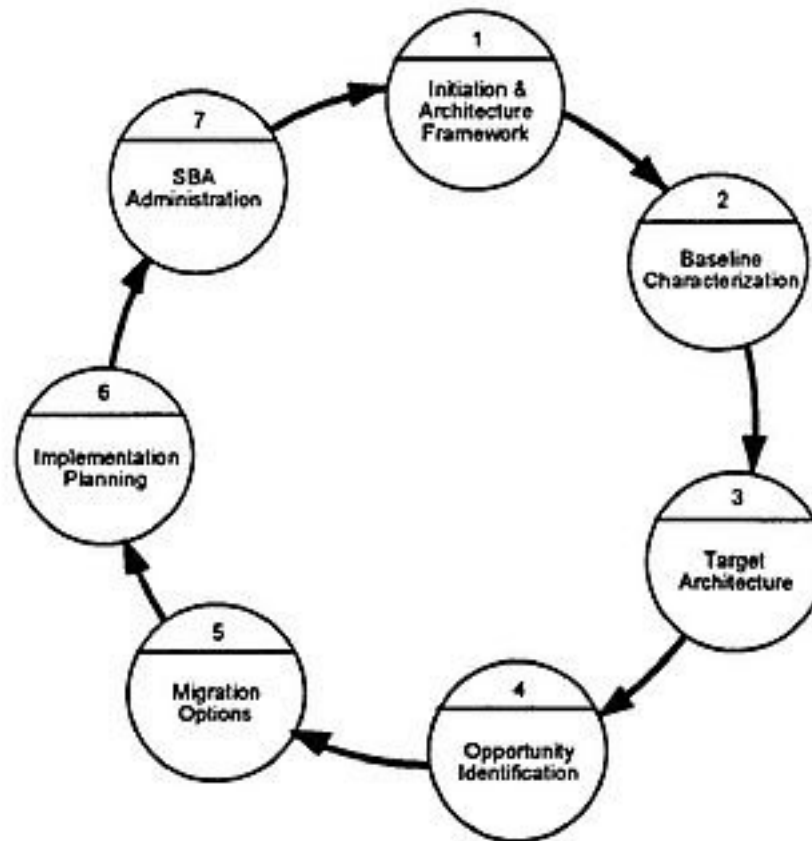

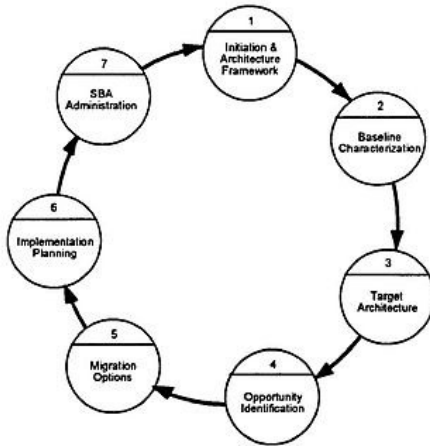
Imagine that you use (or want to use) the following approach to strategic planning

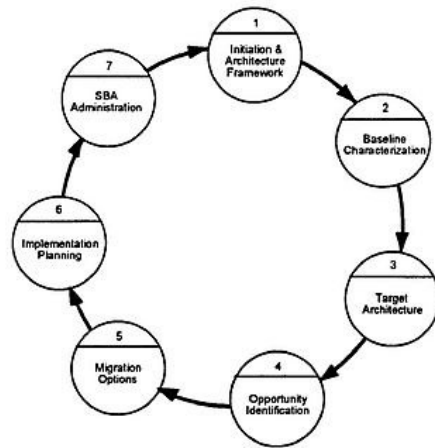

# How to identify a mediocre approach Eg 4.1

## Explanation



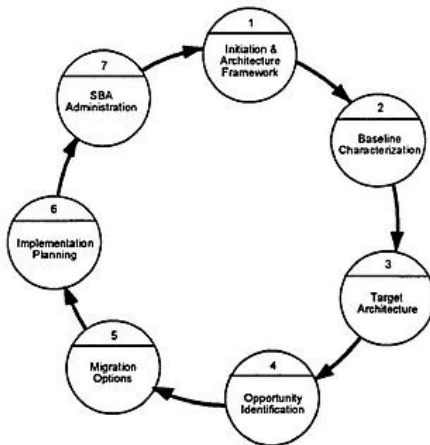
Why is it pointless?

- 1) Step 1 – Architecture vision  
Deliverables called ‘catalogues’ are far too implicit. Will require multiple brain storming sessions. Hence mediocre
- 2) Step 2 – Baseline  
Deliverables called ‘matrices’ and ‘diagrams’ are far too implicit. Will require multiple brain storming sessions. Hence mediocre
- 3) Step 3 – Target architecture – Irrelevant step as too many mediocre previous steps
- 4) Technology steps - Irrelevant step as too many mediocre previous steps
