An open letter to any technologically minded entrepreneur willing to listen to my idea of using holographic technology or virtual reality to display the output of strategic planning (business objectives and knowledge model) and information technology (data base) objects.

Sir/Madam

Please allow me to introduce myself across the vast expanse of space and time via the internet. My name is Charles Meyer Richter, currently a 68 year old male, born in South Africa to Jewish parents and an Australian citizen since 1983.

I have over 40 years experience in the information technology industry, am the founder of Ripose Pty Limited (1994), the developer of the Ripose Technique and Ripose compilers (aka Caspar - computer assisted strategic planning and reasoning engine).

This open letter is penned as a means to explore the possibility of gaining a hearing with any technically minded entrepreneur who wants to advance mankind's future using an advanced strategic planning framework - modelled on Immanuel Kant's work called the Critique of Pure Reason and thoroughly modernised by selecting the best practice techniques from modern managerial practices, information architecture and software engineering approaches.

To date the outputs of both the Ripose Techniques Proof of concept (a blue print of the strategic planning component) and the Proof of logic (a blue print of the information technology project management planning component) are in a printed format. With the aide of modern technology, I can see a future where the outputs of Caspar can, not only be displayed, but also walked around and edited in either virtual reality or a holographic format.

I have the technology to create all the objects for both the business strategic planning and information technology phases of any size enterprise (including the individual) in a sequitur, with no redundancies and timely manner. There are however, three missing components. Two from my software: 1) a holographic or virtual reality display & edit component and 2) the ability to generate computer code from pseudo code into C++, C#, Java, JavaScript (or any other language). And one from my business plan (to popularise the Ripose Technique and therefore attract, train and remunerate good information architects, whilst the marketing and sales arm builds the Ripose architect market).

At 68, retired and living on the aged pension, I do not have the resources (money, technology nor the people) to make these a reality. It is for this reason that I turn to someone with the ability, wherewithal and willingness to help me fund and develop these three missing components.

If I have to I can produce a detailed business plan (as I have done in the past) however, these take time and are often too detailed and finding the right person to pitch the business plan at is often very hit and miss. As I have no idea as to the cost of developing a holographic image, nor for that matter a virtual reality model, I would only be guessing.

Please consider these propositions (I wonder how many of those activities ever saw a business plan produced):

- 1) If NASA can spend billions of dollars sending a human being into space, or send a space capsule millions of miles to play a 'greetings from planet earth' to an unknown and unseen species, or
- 2) scientists spend billions of dollars creating a cyclotron to accelerate particles at enormous speeds, just to see what sort of compound they can create when the two particles collide or
- 3) Medical science have spent millions of dollars trying to find the cure for the common cold and have not yet managed to, but press on with trying to solve 'more complex' problems

I saw a major problem in the information technology sector and I fixed it. I sought funding to assist me write the Ripose compilers to help me automate the framework, ended up funding it myself and delivered it. I sought funding to assist me build the project management tool component of the Ripose compiler, ended up funding it myself and delivered it. The hologram and virtual reality output components are but a dream and not really a necessity, but it would look great. Consider this, the tablet and smart phones are not really a necessity, but they do look great. The driverless car is not really a necessity, but it would look great.

Should my request fall on deaf ears, I will continue to pursue my 'dream'. It will probably take the rest of my life (hopefully 20 to 25 years) but when one is thriving on a semi self funded aged pension, I can afford to wait (but then again my family of nieces, nephews and their offspring, currently living in South Africa may not be so fortunate). If I have to go it alone, the way for me to achieve is this by:

- 1) creating a cd of my life's work and try to sell it. The cd will encapsulating my autobiography, hypotheses, presentations, my book 'Breaking the systems barrier' and internet Caspar (called iCaspar, enabling the adult, humane adult and possibly the humane adolescent begin to describe their dreams in the form of their purpose, benefit and value statements) and hopefully sell enough copies to fund steps 3 through 5
- 2) run 'GetAlife with Prysms' seminars here in Cairns and over the internet
- 3) provide free training to any enterprise architect and software engineers who find the existing frameworks too cumbersome and therefore a burden on their creativity and ethical standards;
- 4) seek to use cloud technology (probably Amazon Ec2 or build my own server and use virtual machine technology) to deploy Caspar, thus enabling information architects to rent the software rather than buy it
- 5) start to fund the marketing and selling arm of Ripose to spread the word about the advanced framework.

However I do not see how I could start to fund the development of the holographic and/or virtual output component of the Ripose Technique, nor the creation of the program generators. Still, for a retired person with over 40 years experience in the IT industry under his belt, achieving 1 and 2 of the above steps, on the meagre aged pension must surely be not too shabby. Steps 3 through 5 may be just a dream.

So what am I offering in return? Ripose Pty Limited does not have a market and only one information architect that could service 3 or 4 clients a year (should I manage to find one and be prepared to travel). What I do have is a superior framework with its supporting software, information architect training material, a library of applications that could be (with clever marketing) begin to bring in a fairly sizeable income as well as the capability of training others. Therefore I am prepared to discuss the offer of a substantial shareholding in Ripose Pty Limited in exchange.
